7th Area QSO Party


Please mark **Saturday May 5th** down on your calendars. This is the date of the **7th Area QSO Party**, the clubs major operating event of the year!

A brief History of EAARS and the

The **7th Area QSO Party** (www.codxc.com/ new/Page.asp?Content=dryland7s) is one of the fastest growing contests in the country since its inception in 2006.

- **2007 N7GP** won the County Expedition category and overall high score. N7GP consisted of many operators that would later become the core group of the EAARS 7QP team.
- **2008** EAARS first official entry in 7QP where the team won both their category and scored the overall high score with 555,520 points.
- **2009** EAARS once again won the *County* Expedition Multi-Multi category and overall high score with 709,195 points.
- 2010 another year, another category win and overall high score with 723,064 points. Notice that EAARS improved on the



previous years score each time.

- 2011 I like to refer to the 2011 7QP as the "time of gnashing teeth and wailing". Due to technical difficulties EAARS did not field a team and the County Expedition Multi-Multi category went to **K7UM** in Utah with a score of 600,180 points, breaking EAARS unbroken winning streak.
- **2012** What will happen this year? Will you come out and help EAARS reestablish its mark on the 7QP? It won't be easy. Looking at the **K7UM** score from last year the competition is getting closer.
