EAARS on EAARS

Chris Buchanan – N7JND

Do you like listening to the EAARS system all the time? Wish you could listen even when you are not by your radio? Maybe you are vacationing in Paris and you want to monitor EAARS from your hotel room? Maybe you are at work and can't have your HT? Well, now you can listen anytime you want. The EAARS website now offers "LIVE" streaming audio of the EAARS system by simply clicking on "Click here to listen to live EAARS repeater audio". You can monitor EAARS audio when and where ever you want.

Actually, this is only one of many ways you can listen to streaming EAARS audio. Maybe you have one of the many police scanner apps installed on your Smartphone. Just navigate to Arizona and select any county and you can then add live EAARS audio to your scanner app. Since EAARS covers many counties in Arizona, you can select it from any county in Arizona. Many police scanner apps are free.

Maybe you don't want to tie up your web browser just to listen to EAARS audio. You can now listen to EAARS audio through Windows Media Player. Just go to www.radioreference.com, click on "Live Audio" and select Arizona. Select your county, scroll down and select "Windows Media Player" on the EAARS entry. Click play and enjoy EAARS streaming audio through your media player. It may download a link to click on for your media player. Other selections are Real Player, iTUNES, Winamp, Java Web Player and Web Player. Web Player will simply play it through your default browser.

The live EAARS audio stream is available 24/7. But keep in mind, there may be up to a 40 second delay from the time the actual transmission takes place until it filters through the internet and arrives at your speaker. Enjoy listening to the EAARS system even when you are out of the normal coverage area. Keep your EARS on EAARS.
